WEEKLY NEWS AND REMINDERS

National Truth & Reconciliation Week Each year, September 30th marks the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. The day honours the children who never returned home and survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process. On Friday, September 29th at AMES we ask staff and students to wear orange to honour First Nations Residential School students. Both the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day take place on Saturday, September 30th. Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to raise awareness of the individual, family and community inter-generational impacts of residential schools, and to promote the concept of "Every Child Matters". The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations. On September 30, we also encourage our AMES family to wear orange to honour the thousands of Survivors of residential schools.

Turnaround Day Yearly, the SCDSB undertakes a process to balance our classes to be compliant with Ministry guidelines for classrooms. This sometimes necessitates the movement of students and restructuring of classes. Communication will be sent home to you September 25th if your child is affected by this process. If your student receives a letter, we ask that your child goes to their old classroom the morning of Wednesday September 27th. We will then take your child to the NEW classroom, so that belongings can be moved, and students can meet the new teacher and become familiar with the new learning space.

School council is a good way for parents/guardians to get involved in their child/children's education while playing an important role in the partnership between home and school.
